

Great things are taking place at the West New York Swim Club (6600 Anthony M. DeFino Way). Mayor Felix E. Roque, M.D. and the Board of Commissioners are pleased to inform you the pools have undergone extensive renovations, including a new water saving, water recapture system.

The Main Pool is currently open Saturdays and Sundays from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm. Beginning June 24 the pool will open Monday through Friday from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Weekend hours will remain 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Both Residents and non residents alike are invited to become members of the West New York Swim Club for a cool and refreshing summer.

Membership fees:

Residents can pay a flat fee of \$99 for a summer membership for the first family member and \$50 for each additional member.

Non-residents can pay a flat fee of \$199 for a summer membership for the first family member and \$50 for each additional member.

Registration must be done in person at the Swim Club, 6600 Anthony M. DeFino Way. Proof of residency is required. All non-residents must be sponsored by a West New York resident. All West New York sponsors must be 18 year of age or older.

Daily rates:

Residents: \$7 weekdays, \$8 weekends and holidays

Non-Residents: \$10 weekdays, weekends and holidays

The West New York Swim Club “kiddie pool” is scheduled to open July Fourth weekend, boasting the most comprehensive overhaul of the pool since its construction in 1979. West New York Swim Club Patrons will enjoy a completely reimagined, state of the art Spray Park. The spray park includes over twelve new water features, palm trees, pirate ships and more.

In addition, Mayor Roque and the Board of Commissioners encourage families looking to cool down to visit West New York’s numerous Sprinkler Parks, opening June 20<sup>th</sup>.
