WHAT: Earth Day is an annual tradition begun in 1970 by U.S. Senator Gaylord Nelson after the massive oil spill in Santa Barbara, California the year before. The very first Earth day marked the birth of the first widespread environmental movement and piggy-backed on the energy of the anti-war protest against Vietnam.

The movement brought the needs of a neglected planet to the forefront and began decades of progressive environmentally-conscious legislation as well as an awareness of the positive affect each individual American can have on Earth's preservation and care.

And our Earth needs care. With the environmental demands our ever-growing population places on our planet, we as responsible inhabitants must work to preserve it for future generations to come.
