West New York Health Fair



On Friday, September 11th, 2015, residents came together at the memorial service held to remember the tragic events of September 11th, 2001. Mayor Felix E. Roque, M.D. and the West New York Board of Commissioners, in conjunction with the West New York Police Department, led the ceremony alongside the North Hudson Regional Fire Department.

Victims from West New York were remembered as Commissioner Colacurcio read the names of William Joseph Cashman, Michael Paris Colbert, and Paul Robert Eckna as the bell was tolled by a local firefighter. The tolling of the bells was also performed in special tribute to the 37 fallen Officers of the Port Authority Police Department, the 23 fallen officers of the New York Police Department, and the 343 fallen firefighters of the New York Fire Department.
