ORDINANCE #10/23

**ORDINANCE DESIGNATING MADISON STREET BETWEEN 62ND STREET AND
64TH STREET IN THE TOWN OF WEST NEW YORK AS A NORTHBOUND ONE-
WAY ROADWAY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. § 39:4-197(1)(c), a municipality in the State of New Jersey is authorized to adopt ordinances designating one-way streets without the approval of the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, it is within the police power of the Town of West New York (the “Town”) to regulate municipal streets within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Remington & Vernick Engineers (“RVE”) completed a traffic analysis of Madison Street as requested by the Town of West New York and has recommended that the Town eliminate the two-way traffic pattern and designate Madison Street between 62nd Street and 64th Street as a northbound one-way roadway; and

WHEREAS, the Town seeks to eliminate two-way traffic and designate Madison Street between 62nd Street and 64th Street as a northbound one-way roadway in the Town of West New York to create a more consistent traffic pattern along that roadway.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of West New York do hereby authorize as follows:

SECTION ONE:

The following NJDOT local roadway within the jurisdiction of the Town of West New York shall be converted from a two-way roadway into a northbound one-way local roadway with the statutory residential speed limit of 25 MPH.

<u>Street</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>
Madison Street – from 62 nd Street to 64 th Street	Northbound One-Way

SECTION TWO:

The following signage and pavement striping/markings changes are required to convert Madison Street from 62nd Street to 64th Street from a two-way roadway to a northbound one-way roadway:

- Remove “STOP” pavement markings on the approach to 62nd Street.
- Remove “one-way” and “no left turn” signs on 62nd Street.
- Install “one-way” and “do not enter” signs for Madison Avenue at 64th Street in the Town of West New York.
- Replace “no parking this side” signs along Madison Street between 62nd Street and 64th Street.

SECTION THREE:

Severability. If any term or provision of this Ordinance is held to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, in whole or in part, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining terms and provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR:

Repealer. To the extent that any provision of the Code of the Town of West New York is found to conflict with this Ordinance, in whole or in part, this Ordinance shall control.

SECTION FIVE:

In order to avoid accidental repeal of existing provisions, the Town Clerk and the Corporation Counsel are hereby authorized to change any chapter numbers, article numbers and/or section numbers in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between those numbers and the existing Code.

SECTION SIX:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
