Veterans Diversion Program

The Veterans Diversion Program is a program for eligible service members who come into contact with the court system. A prosecutor decides who can get into the program. The prosecutor also decides how long the person stays in the program. Support services in the program include mental health and addiction services. A judge will dismiss the criminal charges when the person finishes the program successfully.
